

Posted property management guidelines in Boslaugh and the Church building

Flint Hill School electricians replaced burned out parking lot lights

The exterior of the church building had work done by Worldgate

damaged Efls was repaired

damaged base trim was removed

the exterior was power washed

all windows were caulked

decoy Owls were placed at four strategic highpoints on the building to deter woodpeckers and other unwanted visitors from causing future damage

An office space for Will Packard was formed in Boslaugh by dividing the "Purple Room" meeting space into two rooms

A church HVAC compressor was replaced (one of six) in the larger unit servicing the Sanctuary. Our HVAC systems still uses R22 which is being phased out by 2020; need to plan for complete replacement of both units soon.

The church piano was refurbished

Lopez Tree Service was hired to cut down 28 dead and diseased (Ash) trees.

The process was halted after 11 trees were removed as chapel repurposing will proceed in July 2018 to cut and use the lumber for future church projects with Mark Boyer and Richard Decker in charge.

The acquisition of a trailer for campus use is a work in progress.

Vestry approved the spend and the GM is working with Loudoun County to obtain the authorization required to proceed

An 8ft X 28ft new storage shed was purchased and installed on the North end of the church property on the old concrete propane tank pad

Two new chair racks were purchased to replace the old racks in the church building; Usage Guidelines were published and distributed to most key contacts to get the word out on how best to load and unload the racks

Sound and Music Team working to finalize their recommendations for Sound Improvements in the Church.

Current system issues:

- Convert our 2-mixer system to a single mixer located at the current sound booth.
- Upgrade our portable speaker system to one designed for our space.
- Fix our current system's feedback issues and sound quality issues.
- Fix reliability issues we have with our current system.

The Church sponsored two Eagle Scout projects on campus for Boy Scout Troop 58. The Butterfly Garden in the NE Corner of the parking lot was completed and the refurbishment of the old vegetable garden (next to the Adult Ed room) was started, with a completion expected in early 2018

Converted and upgraded Church Office Phones to modernize the system and improve reliability

Cemetery – A funeral service and In-Ground burial was held for parishioner Ellen Lyford in plot A98.
