



Staff COVID Policy Guidelines

As of August 9, 2021 because at present the delta variant is increasing the threat of COVID infection, all staff members will be required to wear masks indoors regardless of vaccination status. Staff members who are unvaccinated are strongly encouraged to work from home as they are able. All staff members are permitted to work from home as circumstances allow.

Testing and Exposure Guidelines:

- If you are feeling ill or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms notify your supervisor or the rector, stay home and get tested.
- If you have been exposed to someone who has COVID notify your supervisor or the rector and consider self-isolating and get tested 3-5 days after exposure.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 stay home for 7-10 days or until a negative test result or cleared by a physician and notify your supervisor or the Rector.

Travel Guidelines:

- After domestic travel staff members should self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms; isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms. Follow all state and local recommendations or requirements. Staff members do NOT need to get tested or self-quarantine if they are fully vaccinated or have recovered from COVID-19 in the past 3 months.
- After international travel staff members must get tested with a viral test 3-5 days after travel. and self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms; isolate and get tested if they develop symptoms.

This policy will be reviewed regularly and revised according to CDC guidelines, diocesan guidelines, and local metrics.
